OUR MISSION

These children may beg, steal, dig through trash, shine shoes or do other odd jobs in order to survive. FEED MY SHEEP MINISTRY

By the grace of God and through the relationships that Marvin & Karen Steinke have developed in Honduras since they first visited in 2001, Feed My Sheep Ministry:

- Supports 2 feeding projects where more than 275 kids are fed hot meals each week.
- Provides 2-3 medical clinics that serve about 300 people per clinic. These clinics cost an average of \$3.00 per person and include seeing a doctor and receiving vital de-worming medicines.
- Provides scholarships for more than 170 students. Scholarships cost \$125 per student and include tuition, uniforms, books, & supplies.
- Spends time during the missions trips working on special building projects, the last two projects included a clean water supply system and a school/kitchen building project.
- Distributes 4,000 Spanish Bibles, every mission trip, to individuals around San Pedro Sula.
- Finds great JOY in being the hands and feet of Christ in Honduras.

Feed My Sheep Ministry is blessed to have a large number of wonderful volunteers who support the ministry. We have a wonderful **"HOME" Team** and 70 people who have gone to Honduras to help.



Due to the poverty in Honduras:

- 84% of the children have inferior mental health
- 64% of the children have inferior physical health
- More than 40% have substantial dietary deficiency
- More than 50% have not been able to see a doctor, parasites are left untreated and are the children's #1 health issue.
- 94% of the street children do not eat three meals a day
- 2% were undersized
